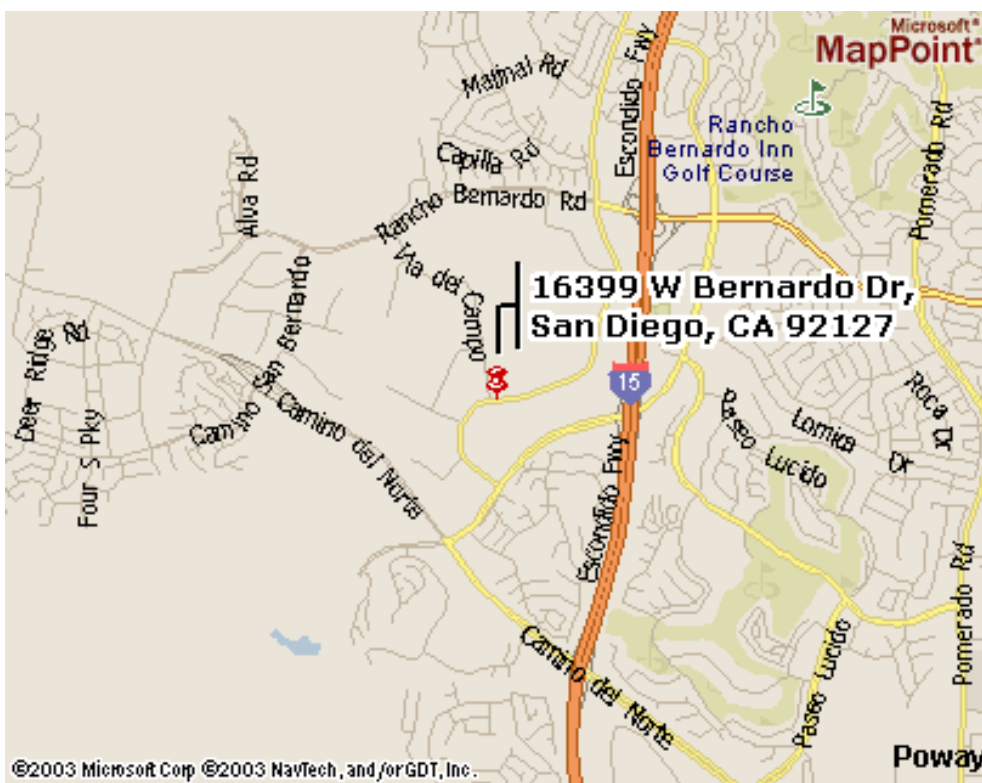


2005 MATHCOUNTS Information Sheet

Take Rancho Bernardo Road Exit off I-15 heading west. Turn left (south) at West Bernardo Drive. Enter at HP main gate (just north of Via del Campo) and park in lots near palm trees.

Registration

Check-in will be in the Café. All guests must wear visitor badges, issued by HP Security, while on site. Coach should pick up certificates for students and themselves. Please check for spelling errors, make corrections on certificate and give to Coordinator. All students, guests and coaches must remain in the Café or adjacent courtyard until told otherwise (start of testing). Home schools should complete a Home School Affidavit.

Site Access

All students, guests and coaches are free to be inside the Café or adjacent courtyard throughout the day. Only students and volunteers are allowed in the Conference Center during testing. All students, guests and coaches are allowed inside the Surf/Turf/Cove

rooms during the Countdown Round and Awards Ceremony. Students and Coaches are not allowed inside the Grader's Room at any time. Once the proctors dismiss the students from their rooms, they may go back to the Café for their breaks. No one is allowed to access other areas of the HP facility from the Conference Center.

Testing Format

An announcement will be made at around 9:15 am telling the students where to report for the Sprint Round. The proctor will lead them to the rooms. The individuals will compete in different rooms than the team members. The procedure for each test will be presented by the proctor. Due to time constraints, individuals cannot take the team test. The individual testers will report back to the Café after the Target Round. The Countdown Round is a fast-paced one-on-one competition. If guests can only be at one part of the event, this is it. The rules for the Countdown Round will be presented to the students and audience. Please refer to the Mathcounts Handbook for rules. The Coordinator will make all decisions affecting the results of the competition.

What Coaches need to do prior to the competition

1. Send in a Team/Individual Roster to the Coordinator by February 4.
2. Send in a Guest List to the Coordinator by February 4
3. Provide guests with directions to HP (available at www.mathcounts-ca.org)
4. Insure students know the date of the state competition (March 12, 2005 at UC-Irvine) to avoid conflicts. The national competition takes place May 5-8, 2005 in Detroit.

What Coaches need to do on the day of the competition

1. Make sure all individuals are registered and have visitor badge
2. Make sure students understand that team member and individuals from the same school will be competing in different rooms.
3. Attend the coaches meeting at 8:45 am
4. Inform students about site access restrictions
5. Stress that students are not to verbalize answers during the Countdown Round

Food

All food will be located in the Café. You can bring your own, if you want.

Non-Student Test Takers

A small number of 2004 Sprint and Target tests will be available so that coaches and guests can take their tests at the same time the students are. The tests will be self-graded.

Countdown Round

The Countdown Round will pit the top 16 individual scorers against each other in a “Sweet 16” format. The students will be completing only for awards and prizes. The results of the Countdown Round will not have an impact on advancement to State. Student may decline to compete. In this case, the next highest scorer will be allowed to compete.

Coach/Guest Activities

Visitors typically socialize, read a book or solve math problems while testing takes place. We will show a movie if the A/V system allows.
